Mount Washington Valley Soccer Club is dedicated to the development of soccer players and strives to promote good sportsmanship on the field and from the sidelines. Both players and spectators are involved to enjoy this beautiful game, for good competition, and to experience all the fun this game can offer. With this in mind, MWVSC has the following expectations for those associated with the Club. This includes players, parents, guardians, spectators, coaches, volunteers, directors and board members.

1.) You officially represent the Mount Washington Valley Soccer Club on and off the field. We expect good sportsmanship and good citizenship. Proper respect must be given to coaches, staff, referees, spectators, and opponents.

2.) Parents, sponsors, spectators, volunteers, guardians, play an important role in the success of the Club. We expect the following:

- Encourage and model good sportsmanship
- Support and respect the program, coaches, directors, and volunteers.
- Use constructive remarks and refrain from negative comments in front of players
- Participate in fundraising events and sponsorship opportunities.
- Respect the decisions and tactical strategies of the coaching staff. Do not “coach” from the sideline; as that will confuse the players.

3.) Refrain from all manner of personal abuse, bullying and harassment of others, whether verbal, physical, emotional or sexual.

4.) Players will refrain from using any illegal substances or tobacco products, or alcohol. Adults are encouraged to refrain from the use of tobacco products and alcohol in the presence of players during certain club events. Some event locations occur at restaurants, where alcohol is served. Adults are expected to conduct themselves with the utmost respect in the presence of players.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct will be brought to the Board for possible disciplinary action and possible suspension or dismissal.
